Professor Emeritus of European Law, Sapienza University, Rome; Professor of European Union Law, Luiss University, Rome; Senior Fellow of the Luiss School of European Political Economy; member of the Scientific Council of the Luiss School of Law. Member of the Steering Committee of the Italian Institute of International Affairs (IAI), of the Scientific Committee of the Italian Arbitration Association (AIA), the Executive Committee of the journals the “Rivista italiana delle Scienze Giuridiche” and “Studi dell’integrazione europea”. Amongst the founders of “Europeos”, an association of scholars aiming to contribute to the European integration.

Prof. Tosato is a practising lawyer, head and founder of Studio Legale Tosato; frequently involved in international arbitrations; judge of the Court of Unidroit (the International Institute for the Unification of Private Law). Former Chairman of Ericsson Italy (1981-2006), presently Honorary Chairman of this company and Chairman of the L.M. Ericsson Foundation. Former Chairman of the ICC Commission on Computing, Telecommunications and Information Policies, in Paris (1993 – 1996). In 2000 he was awarded the title of Labour Merit of the Italian Republic.

Prof. Tosato is author and editor of numerous publications of public and private international law and European law. His recent publications include books on International Economic Law (1992), International Trade Law (1996), Economic and Monetary Union (1999, 2007), European Competition Law – Procedure (2004, 2006, 2015). He edited, with Stefano Micossi, the volume “The European Union in the 21st century. Perspectives from the Lisbon Treaty” (CEPS, 2009).
